
WEEKENDS (ONLY BOARDING)

Camp Fees and Discounts

Early Bird Discount:

Applications submitted with 50% of the camp fee paid before May 3rd, 2024 will be entitled to a 1,000 MYR discount on camp fees.

Four-Week Discount:

Students who apply for 4 weeks of camp will be eligible for a 5% discount off their camp fee.

Sibling Discount:

Siblings of the first child attending one or more camps qualify for a 5% discount.
