Camp Fee & Discounts

Early Bird Discount:

Applications submitted with 50% of the camp fee paid before **22 November 2024 (for camps 1 and 2) and 6 December 2024 (camps 3,4, and 5)** will be entitled to a 1,000 MYR discount on camp fees.

Four-Week Discount:

Students who apply for 4 weeks of camp will be eligible for a 5% discount off their camp fee.

Sibling Discount:

Siblings after the first child attending one or more camps qualify for a 5% discount.
