Curriculum Overview

The RAS Summer Camp is designed to enhance students' English speaking skills through a structured, immersive learning experience. The curriculum is divided into three levels; Basic, Intermediate, and Advanced - each focusing on different aspects of communication, expression, and critical thinking.

English Foundations

Objective

Objective: Build a foundation in pronunciation, vocabulary, and basic interactions while fostering enthusiasm for learning English

Key Components:

- **Basic Greetings & Politeness:**
Master essential phrases like "Hello," "Goodbye," "Please," and "Thank you."
- **Simple Self-Introduction:**
Learn to introduce oneself by name and age.
- **Everyday Vocabulary:**
Build a foundation with common words (e.g. colors, numbers, animals, fruits).
- **Listening Skills:**
Develop early listening comprehension through simple English songs and short stories.

Class Activities:

- **Flashcard Matching:**
Pairing words with images to reinforce vocabulary.
- **Role-Playing: Greetings & Introductions:**
Practice basic conversations in a supportive environment.
- **Storytime Listening:**
Engaging with simple English stories to build listening skills

Expected Outcome:

- Use basic greetings and politeness phrases.
- Introduce themselves using simple sentences.
- Understand and use basic everyday vocabulary.
- Develop enthusiasm for English, setting the stage for further learning.

Level 1 (Basic)

Communication Skills Training

Objective

Develop fundamental English conversation skills, build confidence in real-life interactions, and improve fluency in everyday situations.

Key Components:

- **Situational Speaking Practice:**
Ordering food, shopping, asking for directions, and school interactions.
- **Common Everyday Topics:**
Self-introduction, hobbies, travel, and school life.
- **Interactive Speaking Exercises:**
Pair discussions, role-playing, and Q&A practice.
- **Pronunciation & Intonation Training:**
Correcting common errors and improving clarity.

Class Activities:

- Role-playing exercises.
- Q&A practice games.
- Basic storytelling activities

Expected Outcome:

By the end of the course, students will confidently engage in basic conversations and handle everyday communication effectively..

Level 2 (Intermediate)

Expressive Speaking

Objective

Develop structured speaking skills, enabling students to describe, explain, and express opinions clearly and logically.

Key Components:

- **Descriptive Speaking:**
Talking about people, places, and experiences.
- **Opinion-Based Responses:**
Explaining preferences and justifying choices.
- **Sentence Expansion Techniques:**
Using "5W1H" (Who, What, When, Where, Why, How) to enhance responses.
- **Logical Connectors & Transitions:**
Introducing structured speech with phrases like "Firstly, In addition, To conclude."

Class Activities:

- One-minute impromptu speeches.
- Group discussions.
- Structured storytelling practice

Expected Outcome:

Students will be able to construct full sentences, expand their responses, and articulate their thoughts in an organized and engaging manner.

Level 3 (Advance)

Critical Thinking & Debate

Objective

Develop critical thinking and debate skills.

Key Components:

- **Complex Topics:**
Social issues, technology, education.
- **Argument Building:**
Reasoning, examples, counterpoints.
- **Persuasive Speaking:**
Advanced vocabulary and structure.
- **Debate Skills:**
Logical argumentation and rebuttals.

Class Activities:

Mini debates, panel discussions, public speaking.

Expected Outcome:

Students will confidently debate, present, and express complex ideas.

Camp Fee & Discounts

Early Bird Discount:

Applications submitted with 100% of the camp fee paid before **9th May 2025** (for Camps 1 and 2) and **23rd May 2025** (Camps 3,4, and 5) will be entitled to a 1,000 MYR discount on camp fees.

Four-Week Discount:

Students who apply for 4 weeks of camp will be eligible for a 5% discount off their camp fee.

Sibling Discount:

Siblings after the first child attending one or more camps qualify for a 5% discount.

AIRPORT TRANSPORT

Please contact your agent or representative for private airport transfers from Senai and Changi Airport. It is advisable to arrive via Senai, as the airport is only 25-30 minutes from Raffles American School and does not require a second border crossing.

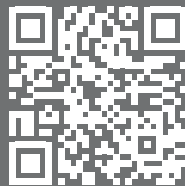
